THE ECER

ECER, the European Congress of Ethnic Religions, is an international organization, based in Vilnius - Lithuania, whose purpose is to associate, promote and defend against discrimination groups that cultivate ethnic religions in Europe.

By ethnic religion we mean a religion, a spirituality, a cosmology historically rooted in the traditions of a particular people.

All forms of occultism, the syncretic neo-confessions and the expressions of modern religious ideologies are excluded.

MOVIMENTO TRADIZIONALE ROMANO

WHO WE ARE: The MTR - Movimento Tradizionale Romano (Traditional Roman Movement) is the longest and most esteemed Italian organization that today cultivates ancient Roman religiosity. Founded in 1988 as the Movimento Tradizionalista, it took its current name in 1998. The Movement, based in Rome in Via Bezzecca 1/d, boasts members throughout Italy and promotes research, correct practice and rediscovery of the Roman Path to the Gods with public and private initiatives; see www.saturniatellus.com.

WHAT WE DO: The members of the Movement practice Roman religiosity exclusively in the private sphere. Today the ancient public state cult linked to the Res Publica is impractical. The foundation of the Roman cult is the Pax Deorum Hominungue, the pact between God and juridically established men: in

the private sphere it is the unwritten covenant between the practitioner and his divinities, sanctioned and maintained through worship.

ROMAN WORSHIP: The cult follows the Julian Calendar and has its own sacred model of formulas, hymns, actions: the Gods are honored with offers of perfumes, vegetables, wine and food (no bloody sacrifices). Everyone is a priest of himself and venerates his own Genius or Iuno, the family Lares, the Penates and the deities he considers protectric of himself, the family and the community, and the deities to whom the feasts of the Calendar are consecrated. The most important ritual occasions are celebrated communally: Birth, Puberty, Marriage, Death, Calends, Ides, None, Beginning of the Sacred Year, Ides of March, Founding of Rome, Capitoline Triad, Saturnalia, etc.
