

## WHO WERE THE CELTS?





The Celts migrate


The years 400 to 200BC are a time of movement.



#### Who were they?

The Iron Age is the age of the "Celt" in Britain. Over the 500 or so years leading up to the first Roman invasion a Celtic culture established itself throughout the British Isles. Who were these Celts? For a start, the concept of a "Celtic" people is a modern and somewhat romantic reinterpretation of history. The "Celts" were warring tribes who certainly wouldn't have seen themselves as one people at the time.






Where did they come from?
What we do know is that the people we call Celts gradually infiltrated Britain over the course of the centuries between about 500 and 100 B.C. There was probably never an organized Celtic invasion; for one thing the Celts were so fragmented and given to fighting among themselves that the idea of a concerted invasion would have been ludicrous.

The Celts were a group of peoples loosely tied by similar language, religion, and cultural expression. They were not centrally governed, and quite as happy to fight each other as any non-Celt. They were warriors, living for the glories of battle and plunder. They were also the people who brought iron working to the British Isles.






#### Mode of life

The Celts were distinguished by reverence expressed by the word, so the druids and the Phillida was at a premium. Killing or harming the druids and filida was considered the greatest disgrace and a serious crime. For the ancient Irish, every sickness was equivalent to death. So the Royal throne in any case could not take a cripple, or a mentally ill person.

During the meal, great company sat in a circle. The Celts sat on the ground, or spread the furs, sometimes they had a low table. Periodically organized meetings-the holidays. They were accompanied by merrymaking, primarily equestrian competitions and Mart, exchange and

communication of every kind.




### Celtic Society

- Celtic society was divided into an elite class of warriors, professional groups of priests and bards, and the common people.
- The warriors owned land and livestock and monopolized wealth and power.
- Warriors fought naked and took heads
- The priests, called Druids, who believed in reincarnation, were teachers and judges as well as religious leaders.



#### **Ancient Druids**


- At the top of society were the chief priests, or Druids.
- Composed hymns, poems, and historical records.
- Served as judges.
- Conducted religious ceremonies in the woods or at sites such as Stonehenge.



• THE DRUIDS— IN PRE-CHRISTIAN SOCIETY FORMED AN INTELLECTUAL CLASS OF PHILOSOPHERS, JUDGES, TEACHERS, DOCTORS, ASTRONOMERS AND ASTROLOGERS. VERY OFTEN THE DRUIDS WERE EVEN MORE POWERFUL THAN TRIBAL CHIEFS, BECAUSE PRIESTS ADVISED THEM IN

ALL DIFFICULT MATTERS.

• The word "Druid" is of Celtic origin, emerged from The combination of "Drus" (Meaning a tree, usually an OAK), and "wid" (Meaning Knowledge and Wisdom).




• So in the Celtic social system "Druid" was a title given to learned men and women possessing "oak knowledge" (or "oak wisdom").

• To become a Druid students assembled in large groups for instruction and training. This period of training could last up to twenty years.


• Many students were women. Celtic women had more freedom and rights than women in any other contemporary culture.

 Great influence in Celtic Druids used the priests, which were concentrated in the hands of the implementation of the highest judiciary and education.

#### Druids:

Druids were the link between the supernatural world and the ordinary human one. They were able to predict what would happen in the future by interpreting nature. It is likely that they knew how to read and write, and they certainly had a good grasp of mathematics. They knew something of medicine and law, and they could trace the stars and the planets. The main centre of the druids in Britain was Anglesey, in Wales.

In Gaul the main centre of the Druids was the Carnutes Forest



#### **DRUIDS**

In the Celtic religion the word Druidry means the practices of the ancient druids, the priestly class in ancient Celtic societies. Their influence was as much social as religious; infact they could be philosophers, scientists, teachers, judges and councillors to the King. The Druids linked the Celtic people with their numerous gods, the lunar calendar and the sacred natural order. The Ancient Order of Druids was founded in 1781 by Henry Hurle.




- The Druid Revival (18th C.) (Meso-pagan Druidry)
- An Druidh Uileach Braithreachas (1717) founded by John Toland (A.D.U.B.), Primrose
  - "Druid Circle of the Universal Bond"
- Scholarly likely to have been a "gentleman scholar's" club, research rather than practice
- Concerned with inculcating celtic morality into British life (concern for hospitality, law, etc.)
- Two current groups the Ancient Druid Order and The Order of Bards, Ovates, and Druids trace their lineage back to this group
